



IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ENERGY STRATEGY 2050 IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMME ESPT 2050

MANAGEMENT SUMMARY, ACTIVITIES UP TO 2017

The Energy Strategy for Public Transport programme (ESöV 2050) strives to improve energy efficiency in public transport and encourage the sector to increasingly cover its energy needs using renewable sources, thereby contributing to the federal government's energy strategy and boosting the industry's competitiveness.

The programme allows public transport companies to tap into funding, expertise and a network of contacts enabling them to identify attractive measures and implement these themselves. The programme is designed to serve as a catalyst and enabler.

Since its launch in 2013, 49 projects with a total funding volume of over CHF 20 million have been initiated. The share financed by the FOT generally amounts to 40%, i.e. the industry bears a large portion of the costs itself. So far the emphasis has been on heating, ventilation and air-conditioning of vehicles, economical driving and rail infrastructure.
